AUTOTEXTLIST Dear **PCC Music Explorer Members and Families:**

Welcome to the 2019-2020 season of the Platteville Children's Choir (PCC)! We are thrilled that your child will be part of our **MUSIC EXPLORERS (ME)** program. This mailing contains important administrative materials. Your response is required to ensure your child is properly enrolled in ME.

Enclosed, please find:

- 1. Your singer's Letter of Agreement:** This letter needs to be signed by both the member and the parent/guardian. Your Letter of Agreement states that you have read it and understand that regular attendance to ME sessions is required in order for your singer to move on to the full-year more advanced performing choirs of PCC.
- 2. Pre-addressed, stamped envelope:** This envelope is included for you to return your Letter of Agreement and the **deposit of \$50** for each singer, payable to Platteville Children's Choir, due by August 21, 2020. The balance of **\$50** is due on or before the January 27, 2020, the first date of Music Explorers (ME). If you prefer, you may certainly pay the full amount of \$100 when returning your registration materials.
- 3. The PCC Family Guide:** The Family Guide contains information about all of our programs. Much of this information does not pertain to the Music Explorer program but will help you understand what PCC is all about as an organization and the possibilities of your singer's participation all the way through 8th grade. The calendar on the back does coincide with the Music Explorers program except for the performance activities of School Tour and Spring Concert. Music Explorers does not have any public performances. A parent/family "Open Rehearsal" will occur on the date indicated in the Family Guide.

**January 27th, 2020**, 6:30 PM, is the date and time of the first session of Music Explorers! This and all future sessions will be held at the lower level of the First English Lutheran Church (FELC), 215 W Pine St, Platteville. Use the back door entrance and park in the back for your convenience.

We are pleased to have Mrs. Susan Cramer as our director for the Music Explorers program. Mrs. Cramer is a Platteville Chorale board member and an affiliate of the "Music Together" program. She looks forward meeting you all at the first session of the Music Explorers program.
